

LBA 85th Annual Schobermesse Festival Scholarship Application

REQUIREMENTS

- One (1) \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to the winner
- Must be a member of the Luxembourg Brotherhood of America in good standing as of 4/1/2022 and a U.S. citizen or lawful resident.
- You must be enrolled in a 2 or 4-year undergraduate college or trade school as a full-time student, or have been accepted for admission to a college or university and will begin classes no later than the fall semester of 2022.
- Must be 25 yrs old or younger (as of June 1st, 2022). Previous LBA scholarship winners are not eligible.
- Application submission must include the following:
 - ➤ Proof of full-time enrollment/acceptance into college
 - ➤ 500-word original essay on one of the following topic:

With each new generation of Luxembourg-Americans, the percentage of Luxembourg heritage within one's total heritage declines. Being part of Gen Z, you are most likely three or four generations removed from your Luxembourg-born ancestors. Despite this gap and declining percentage, why is your Luxembourg heritage important to you? What makes you proud to be of Luxembourgish decent? What about Luxembourg do you identify with and how will you ensure that your Luxembourg heritage will continue to be important to the next generation?
